ABSTRACT

This conference will address the persistence and transformation of labor informality in Latin America, in dialogue with European debates on segmentation and precariousness. From ECLAC's structuralist perspective, it will examine the historical roots of productive heterogeneity and its links to inequality and low productivity, as well as the impacts of globalization and digitalization, with the aim of fostering a comparative reflection between Latin American and European academic traditions.
