ABSTRACT

This discussion examines labour informality from three complementary perspectives: recent methodological changes in its measurement in Argentina and their implications for empirical analysis; comparative evidence on youth labour-market insertion in Argentina and Europe, focusing on gender, education, firm characteristics, and family background; and the impact of precarious and informal labour trajectories on psychological distress, highlighting how labour-market inequalities affect well-being beyond income outcomes. The session will be in Spanish with automatic translation into English for those who need it.
