ABSTRACT

This conference explores micro-level behavioral drivers of informal employment by integrating rational actor theory, social norms, and the Theory of Planned Behavior. Using PLS-SEM analysis of Polish survey data (N=1017), the findings show that economic rationalization and social normalization strongly increase intentions to engage in informal work, while moral disapproval reduces it. The results highlight the importance of social and moral mechanisms—beyond purely economic factors—in shaping participation in informal employment.
